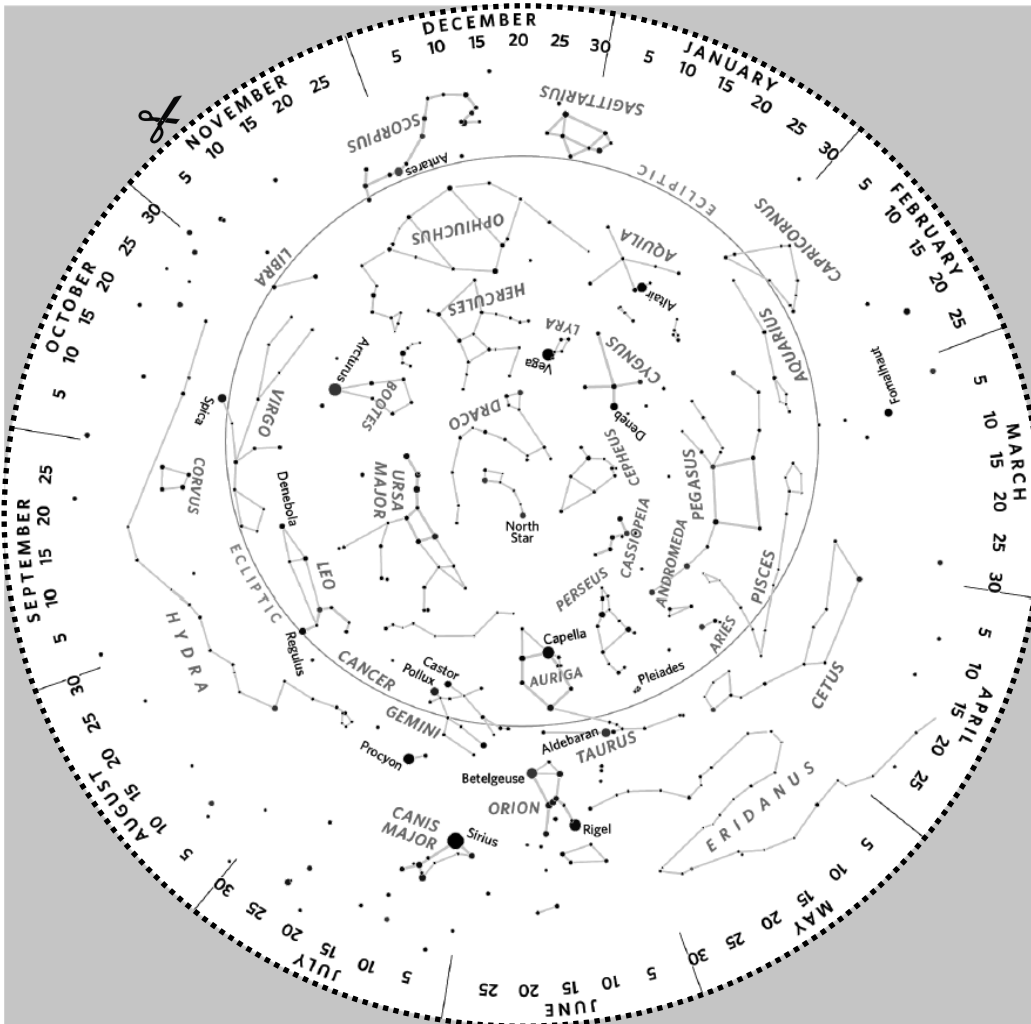




Austin Astronomical Society's

D.I.Y. Planisphere

- Cut out the star wheel as indicated by the dotted line.
- Cut out planisphere along the outer edge and the oval in the middle.
- Fold where indicated.
- Tape the two sides of your planisphere so that the star wheel can be slipped into the enclosed pocket.
- Match up your month and day with your current time and use to determine the location of stars and constellations in the night sky.
- To use hold the planisphere overhead matching the cardinal directions with your orientation.
- ENJOY THE NIGHT SKY!
