



<u>Endangered Bat</u> <u>Passports</u>



Bat Conservation International (BCI) is a global conservation organization on a mission to end bat extinctions world-wide, to ensure a healthy ecosystem and a healthy planet. Learn about the endangered bats that BCI helps all over the world by completing this Endangered Bat Passports activity! Feel free to complete this activity in a group, do the sections over time, or focus on the passports that interest you the most!

<u>Age Group</u>: 10 and up (adult assistance encouraged, activity involves use the internet and a smart phone, tablet, or computer. Younger bat activists or "bativists" can participate with additional parental assistance)

<u>Supplies Needed:</u>

- Activity 4 print-outs (bat passports)
- electronic device (smart phone, tablet, or computer)
- __ markers or colored pencils
- writing utensil
- scissors

<u>Before you start:</u> Gather the supplies above, print out "Endangered Bat Passports" activity, and make sure your electronic device has access to the internet!

<u>Steps for creating your Endangered Bat Passports:</u>

For each passport...

- 1. Cut out Endangered Bat Passport along rounded black rectangle border (do not cut along the middle black line!)
- 2. Next fold passport in half (top to bottom), along middle black line, lining up edges.
- 3. Fill out Endangered bat passports with information from the Bat Conservation International website, by visiting the link in the special instructions at the top of this page, or scanning the QR codes on each passport. More on that next!
- 4. If you have access to a smart phone or tablet, open your camera app and hold your camera over the QR code of the passport you want to complete.
- 5. Click the link that pops up and it will open the section for that endangered species' on the batcon.org website.
- 6. Use the information from the correct section of the website to fill out each passport!
- 7. Color-in and decorate your passports in any style you like!
